<u>ORDER</u>

Plaintiffs have filed a Consent Motion to Stay Case and to Extend Time to Respond to Defendants' Renewed Motion to Dismiss. For good cause shown, the Motion is GRANTED. It is hereby ORDERED as follows:

- The parties are ORDERED to promptly file a joint notice on the docket upon the occurrence of the later of the events described in Paragraph 1 of this Order.

- 3. The Clerk of Court is DIRECTED to submit the parties' joint notice as described in Paragraph 1 of this Order to the Court upon filing.
- Plaintiffs shall file any brief responding to Defendants' renewed motion to dismiss (ECF No. 69) within seven days of the filing of the parties joint notice as described in Paragraph 1 of this Order.
