**UPDATED ISSUES RELEVANT TO THE
JANUARY 11, 2022 STATUS CONFERENCE**

Both before and after the parties' submission of notice to this Court regarding issues to address at the January 11, 2021 status conference, ECF 478, the parties had several sessions to meet and confer about this case. Those sessions have been productive and have provided new information that has led the parties to believe that some of the matters at issue in this case may be able to be narrowed or resolved.

Therefore, the parties request that, instead of the issues the parties expected to raise when they submitted that notice to the Court yesterday, the status conference instead address the parties' joint request for a 60 day delay in the trial, and concurrent delays in associated pre-trial proceedings, in order to continue these discussions. The parties further represent that they wish to engage the assistance of a Magistrate for, at a minimum, the dates originally set aside for this trial, to continue this process.

In addition, pursuant to this Court's order of December 15, 2021, ECF 466, the Plaintiffs have now learned, and therefore notify the Court, that on January 5, 2022, the Defendants approved issuance of an ID card to class representative Alice Weddle. For the reasons stated in the Weddle Plaintiffs' November 18, 2021 Motion to Add or Substitute Class Representative, ECF 457, the Plaintiffs assert that Ms. Weddle remains an adequate class representative and should be permitted to continue to serve as such. Should the Court have additional questions about this issue, deem that not to be the case, the parties would request the opportunity to provide additional briefing, and also to identify additional class representatives. However, in order to proceed most efficiently, the parties also request that any such requirement be stayed pending the discussions in which the parties seek to engage, as discussed above.
