"The foundation of our constitutional republic is the right to free and fair elections. Our nation's founders understood that our government should be by the people and for the people, giving all American citizens a voice in the democratic process. Unfortunately, the general election this past November revealed election irregularities that still have yet to be resolved. Without the necessary investigations into these violations of our electoral laws, I will object to the electoral college certification of the states that have violated the 12th Amendment during today's joint session of Congress.

State laws in the 2020 election were circumvented without the approval of state legislatures, egregiously violating the Constitution that I swore an oath to defend and protect. I sent a letter, joined by dozens of my colleagues, to Speaker Pelosi demanding House leadership open a full investigation into the irregularities reported nationwide, but Speaker Pelosi has yet to respond, choosing to ignore the voices of millions of Americans that have spoken out about their concerns. Our republic depends on fair and honest elections. This year we saw a shift from an Election Day to an election season that included large quantities of mail-in ballots. This experience has raised significant concerns about the security of mail-in ballots, the susceptibility of such ballots to tampering and fraud.

During this year's election, numerous allegations of fraud have been made, and unfortunately some pertain to operations within the U.S. Postal Service which include allegations of discarding mail-in ballots, backdating mail ballots and withholding the processing of one side's campaign mail.

A recent audio recording emerged on the internet of an interview between two federal postal agents and a postal employee whistleblower from Erie, Pennsylvania. Please provide us with the specific steps that were taken to investigate the allegations made by the whistleblower.

On a similar note, how many cases, and in which states, have investigations into fraud or the mishandling of ballots with respect to the general election of 2020 been conducted? Your role in this matter is important to reassuring public confidence in the integrity of the election.

We urge you to investigate any and all potential irregularity or fraud that may contribute to the public's perception of the process and confidence in the outcome. Thank you for your attention to this matter.



On November 6*, you received a letter signed by 39 Members of Congress asking you to use the tools at your disposal to secure the integrity of the 2020 election. We appreciated the news on November 9* that you had authorized federal prosecutors to pursue substantial allegations of fraud.

We are writing today because we are concerned about the shocking lack of action from the Justice Department following your directive. There are a number of anomalies, statistical improbabilities and accusations of fraud that being the election results in several states into question. Affidevits of inegularities in the voting and labolation processes have been swom in a number of jurisdictions. Theeast of retribution by lefting groups with a bistary of substruct have been made against election officials and attorneys for President Trump. And a number of last-minute changes in balloting and counting requirements raise questions about the overall integrity of foderal elections.

With any of the concerns raised about the integrity of ballots cast, it is critical to ensure that we have all the facts and evidence necessary to review. More than enough evidence has been presented to warrant the issuing of subpoents, search warrants and the impounding of helitor nuterials and election devices for forensic analysis. Notably, in Georgia where officials will be preparing for the Senate rusoff election, it is important that election materials, including ording matchines, he preserved for analysis. If any of this investigative activity is currently taking place at any fevel of the Justice Department, it has not been made known to the American people.

There is no doubt that it is the duty of the Justice Department to ensure that the right to vote is sacred. There is also no doubt that the Justice Department must investigate violence or threats of violence against election officials and any citizens participating in the election process.

The post-Election Day delay and inaction is particularly suspect after the long-awaited release of the Dutham report remains tragically behind schedule. For three years, the American people watched as our taxpayer funded hostice department was weaponized against their duly elected President. They have watched with high hopes that those who violated the law in the prooccution of the Russian collusion boox would be held accountable.

In your speech at Hilbdale College Constitution Day Event on Wednesday, September 16, you cloquantly noted that "The great guarantees of the Bill of Rights... are critical sufeguards of

liberty. But as President Reagan used to remind people, the Soviet Union had a constitution too, and it even included some lefts-manuling rights. Ultimately, however, those promises were just empty words, because there was no rule of low to influence them."

105 of my colleagues and I have filed an amicus brief in Texas v. Pennsylvania, et al. Election integrity is a critical component of the American system. The U.S. Constitution gives State Legislatures the exclusive authority to determine the manner in which electors are appointed/chosen.

State and federal law, not the media, set the timeline for certifying election results and the meeting of electors. Throughout my time in public service, I have advocated to preserve the Separation of Powers and for State Legislatures – and Congress – to defend, and when necessary, take back authority given them by the Constitution.

When the role of the State Legislature to make laws is under attacked by the Executive Branch or activist state judges, the Legislature can and should appeal to the U.S. Supreme Court to defend its constitutional authority. In part, as a result of my advocacy in 2000 for Florida to act the Florida Legislature successfully appealed to SCOTUS in Bush v. Gore.

We are a nation of laws and order. We must ensure a constitutionally approved process was conducted and all valid claims are properly addressed. As I said last month, President Trump has the right to take legal action and request recounts to ensure every and only legally cast ballots are counted. Twenty years ago, the news media projected the wrong winner in Florida, and it was about a month before official results of the 2000 Presidential Election were known. Free and fair elections are the bedrock of our republic and it is always right to fight to uphold the constitution when a serious question arises.

In our unique system, Congress is positioned as the last bulwark in a presidential election to ensure the Constitution has been followed. Indeed, just two decades ago, the Supreme Court plainly acknowledged this...

In the four subject states, the legislatures did enact detailed rules and procedures by which those states were to determine their electors. However, as explained in our amicus brief, in the months preceding the 2020 election, those well-established rules and procedures were deliberately changed by a variety of other officials, including governors, secretaries of state, election officials, judges, and private parties.

That usurpation of the legislatures' sole authority, delegated by the Constitution, was a primary reason why the election of 2020 became riddled with an unprecedented number of serious allegations of fraud and irregularities. National polls indicate a large percentage of Americans now have serious doubts about not just the outcome of the current presidential contest, but also the future reliability of our election system itself. We share these grave concerns. However, as it pertains to our constitutional duty as Members of Congress on January 6, we have no express authority or ability to independently prove the many allegations of fraud in the subject states.

Still, we are faced with a seminal legal question. Since we are convinced the election laws in certain states were changed in an unconstitutional manner, the slates of electors produced under those modified laws are thus unconstitutional, not "regularly given" or "lawfully certified" as required by the Electoral Count Act of 1887 (codified as 3 U.S.C. §§ 1, et seq.), and are invalid on their face. Given these inescapable facts, we believe we have no choice but to vote to sustain objections to those slates of electors.
