- 19 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-5-411(a)(2) and (3), concerning the
- 20 methods of voting absentee, are amended to read as follows:
- 21 (2) By delivery of the ballot to the <u>physical office of the</u>
- county clerk of the county of residence of the voter not later than 7:30 p.m.
- 23 on election day by the designated bearer, administrator, or the authorized
- 24 agent of the absentee voter who is medically unable to vote at the regular
- 25 polling site, upon proper verification of the signature of the voter by the
- 26 county clerk and validation of the identity of the authorized agent; or
- 27 (3) By delivery of the ballot to the physical office of the
- 28 county clerk of the county of residence of the voter not later than the time
- 29 the county clerk's office regularly closes on the Friday before election day
- 30 by the registered voter, designated bearer, or administrator of the absentee
- 31 voter, upon proper verification of the signature of the voter by the county
- 32 clerk and validation of the identity of the registered voter, designated
- 33 bearer, or administrator; or
- 34 (4) The voter may deliver the ballot to the physical office of
