NOTICE OF LEGISLATORS' REFERENCES TO RENEWING A VBM
REQUEST BY CHECKING A BOX IN THE LEGISLATIVE RECORD**

On February 8, 2022, the parties were asked to notify the Court regarding any discussion in the legislative record of Senate Bill 90 regarding the option to renew vote-by-mail requests by checking a box. Feb. 8, 2022 Tr. 2317:17-2318:5. In addition to those portions of the record already identified by NAACP Plaintiffs, ECF No. 645, Secretary of State Laurel M. Lee and Intervenor-Defendants also identify the following additional citation from the record for this Court's consideration.

- **ECF 462-29. Florida Legislature Session, House in Session, Senate Bill 90 Third Reading transcript** (April 28, 2021): Tr. 86:5-87:2

State Representative Erin Grall, who at the time was the Chairwoman of the House Public Integrity and Elections Committee, stated during the House floor debate, *inter alia*:

[L]ast cycle we had over 81,000 vote-by-mail ballots that were returned by the post office. That is enough to change the last Governor's race, U.S. Senate race, and Agriculture Commissioner's race. Eighty-one-thousand ballots unused and uncounted. In our society, with the migration of people, four years is too long for a request. A two-year request for a ballot is reasonable. *There is no hardship because supervisors can, as Leon County does and many others, put a request on the back of every vote-by-mail return envelope. So you can renew your request every time you vote.* This will greatly reduce the lost ballots and seeking people who have moved away.
