# PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI TO COMPLETE THE RECORD

Come now, Appellants John Thurston, Sharon Brooks, Bilenda Harris-Ritter, William Luther, Wendy Brandon, Jamie Clemmer, and J. Harmon Smith, in their official capacities as Secretary of State and members of the Arkansas State Board of Election Commissioners, by and through counsel, Attorney General Leslie Rutledge and Assistant Attorney General Brittany Edwards, and for their Petition for Writ of Certiorari to Complete the Record, respectfully state:

1. On March 24, 2022, the circuit court entered an Order declaring Acts 249, 728, 736, and 973 of the 93rd General Assembly unconstitutional and permanently enjoining such acts. The same day, Appellants timely filed their notice of appeal of the circuit court's March 24, 2022, Order with the Arkansas Supreme Court.

- 2. Concurrent with their appeal, Appellants requested a complete transcript of the four-day bench trial held from March 15-18, 2022, and made financial arrangements required for its preparation in accordance with Ark. R. App. 6(b).
- 3. Ms. Neva Warford, the primary court reporter, made requests for additional time to complete the record. Defendants filed four Motions to Extend Time to Lodge the Record, each which the circuit court granted, respectively.
- 4. The current deadline to lodge the record is October 24, 2022. This is the maximum timeframe permitted under Ark. R. App. P. 5(b)(2).
- 5. The hearing record, however, is not yet completely prepared. Ms. Warford communicated to undersigned counsel that she will not have the trial transcript complete by the October 24, 2022, deadline. She has signed an affidavit explaining the delay, a copy of which is attached to this Petition as **Exhibit A**.
- 6. Pursuant to Ark. R. App. P. 5(b)(3), Appellants request that this Court issue a writ of certiorari to Ms. Warford, directing her to complete the hearing record within 30 days of the issuance of said writ.
- 7. This petition is not pursued for the purpose of delay; to the contrary, Appellants communicated diligently with Ms. Warford since the filing their Notice of Appeal in March 2022, in an effort to provide the transcript. Appellants file this Petition to ensure that the briefing schedule can be entered after the trial record is filed and ensure the Court may properly review this appeal.
