DECISION BY THE COURT. This action came before the Court. The issues have been considered and a decision has been rendered.

Consistent with the MEMORANDUM AND ORDER [Doc. 206] filed on July 3, 2025, judgment is entered in favor of plaintiff Voter Participation Center on Count I. The second sentence of K.S.A. § 25-1122(k)(2) is an unconstitutional infringement on plaintiff's First Amendment right to freedom of speech. The Court therefore enjoins defendants from enforcing the second sentence of K.S.A. § 25-1122(k)(2).

By order of the <u>TENTH CIRCUIT MANDATE</u> [Doc. 194] filed on December 4, 2024, judgment is entered in favor of defendants Scott Schwab, Kris Kobach, and Stephen M. Howe on Counts II and III.
