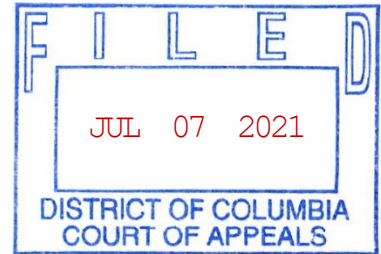

FURTHER ORDERED that respondent's attention is drawn to the requirement of Rule XI, § 14 relating to suspended attorneys and to the provisions of Rule XI, § 16(c) dealing with the timing of eligibility for reinstatement as related
