**PLAINTIFFS' NOTICE
REGARDING PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTION MOTION**

1 At the December 14, 2021 Rule 16 scheduling conference, the parties and the Court
2 discussed the need to structure the case so that, if Plaintiffs decided to file a motion for a
3 preliminary injunction, that motion could be decided sufficiently in advance of the 2022
4 primary and general elections to avoid the concerns identified in *Purcell v. Gonzalez*, 549
5 U.S. 1 (2006) (per curiam). Accordingly, the Court set a deadline of April 22, 2022 for any
6 preliminary injunction motion to be filed. ECF No. 85 ¶ 6. In recently denying a motion
7 for leave to file a proposed *amicus* brief in support of the Attorney General’s motion to
8 dismiss, the Court further noted that, “pursuant to the *Purcell* principle, the Court must
9 resolve the Attorney General’s motion to dismiss and Plaintiffs’ anticipated motion for
10 preliminary injunction (which raise interrelated issues) as quickly as reasonably possible.”
11 ECF No. 117 at 4.

12 In light of the Court’s statements in its February 16, 2022 order, and in light of the
13 pace of discovery, Plaintiffs file this notice to inform the Court that, absent an unforeseen
14 change in circumstances, they will not file a motion for a preliminary injunction seeking
15 relief in advance of the 2022 elections. Should the Court wish to discuss this notice or the
16 case schedule more generally, Plaintiffs will be pleased to do so at the Court’s convenience.
