Petitioners Bria Bennett, *et al.* hereby move this Court for an order adopting a schedule to review any new General Assembly-district plan for compliance with the requirements of the Ohio Constitution, including Article XI, Sections 6(A) and 6(B).

The Court is familiar with this case's background, which Petitioners will not repeat. But given the long period of time that has elapsed since the Court's last opinion, Petitioners briefly recount where the General Assembly redistricting process left off to provide important context for this motion: On May 25, 2022, this Court entered an order sustaining Petitioners' objections to "Map 3" and ordered that plan "invalid in its entirety." League of Women Voters of Ohio v. Ohio Redistricting Comm. ("LWV V"), Slip Opinion No. 2022-Ohio-1727, ¶ 5. The Court further ordered the Ohio Redistricting Commission "to be reconstituted, to convene, and to draft and adopt an entirely new General Assembly-district plan that meets the requirements of the Ohio Constitution, including Article XI, Sections 6(A) and 6(B)." Id. It set deadlines for filing of the district plan, any objections to that plan, and any responses to such objections—all for June 2022. Id. ¶ 6. It also retained jurisdiction for the purpose of reviewing the new plan. Id. The Ohio Redistricting Commission, however, was not reconstituted until this month, on September 13, 2023, more than fifteen months after it was ordered to do so and after all of the deadlines under the Court's governing order have passed. See Ex. 1. The Commission has not yet adopted a new plan or announced precisely when it will do so.

Now that the process of drafting and adopting a new General Assembly-district plan has begun, Petitioners move this Court for a new schedule that will facilitate, if necessary, this Court's orderly review of the new plan under its retained jurisdiction. In particular, Petitioners move this Court to order that:

(1) The Ohio Redistricting Commission shall file the district plan with the Court on the

same date that the plan is adopted;

- (2) Petitioners shall file objections, if any, to the new plan, by 5:00 p.m., five days after the new plan is filed with the Court;
- (3) Respondents shall file responses by 5:00 p.m., three days after any objections are filed; and
- (4) If the deadline for objections or responses falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday, then the objections or response shall be filed by 5:00 p.m. on the next business day thereafter.

Petitioners reached out to all Respondents for their position on this motion, but Respondents were unable to reach a consensus response.
