
## Order Denying Motion for Clarification

Supreme Court Docket No. 49621

Petitioner, Branden Durst, has filed a Motion for Clarification. In essence, the motion for clarification is an effort to obtain an advisory ruling from the Court. This Court declines the invitation to provide an advisory opinion. *See In re Contest of Election*, 164 Idaho 102, 109, 425 P.3d 1245, 1252 (2018) (“[T]his Court does not issue advisory opinions, or offer legal advice to prospective litigants.”). The Motion for Clarification is denied.
