
E N T R Y

This cause originated in this court upon the filing of a complaint invoking this court's original jurisdiction pursuant to Article XIX, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution.

Upon consideration of the petitioners' motion to enforce court's order, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied as procedurally improper. This court entered final judgment in this case on January 14, 2022 and did not retain jurisdiction to review any plan passed or adopted under Article XIX, Section 3(A) or 3(B) of the Ohio Constitution. Petitioners may not, through a motion to enforce, challenge the validity of the congressional redistricting plan adopted on March 2, 2022.

It is further ordered that petitioners' motion for leave to file amended complaint is denied. The motion seeks to add new claims that arose after this court's final judgment on January 14, 2022.

Nothing in this order shall be construed to preclude the filing of a new original action challenging the validity of the March 2, 2022 plan under Article XIX, Section 3(A) of the Ohio Constitution.
