JOINT NOTICE AND PROPOSED SCHEDULING ORDER

The Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals having vacated this Court's liability (ECF No. 274) and remedial injunctions (ECF No. 322) and remanded back to this Court for "further consideration in light of *Callais* and *Milligan*," *Ala. State Conf. of the NAACP v. Sec'y of State for the State of Ala.*, No. 25-13007, 2026 WL 1649570, at *1 (11th Cir. June 8, 2026) (per curiam), the Parties have conferred and hereby submit the following joint case management proposal for the Court's consideration.

1. The Parties agree that no further discovery, re-opening of the record, or second trial is needed to facilitate this Court's reconsideration of this case in light of *Louisiana v. Callais*, 146 S.Ct. 1131 (2026), and *Allen v. Milligan*, 146 S.Ct. 1377 (2026). The Parties agree that they would like to have the opportunity to assist the

Court in resolving this case through supplemental briefing (or other format, if the Court prefers). Accordingly, the Parties propose the following briefing schedule:

- a. Plaintiffs' Opening Brief (60-page limit): due on **September 14, 2026**
- b. Defendant's Response Brief (60-page limit): due on **October 30, 2026**
- c. Plaintiffs' Reply Brief (30-page limit): due on **November 20, 2026**

2. Should the Court wish to hear oral argument on these motions, the Parties respectfully propose such argument be held **on or after December 3, 2026**.
