This cause originated in this court upon the filing of a complaint invoking this court's original jurisdiction pursuant to Article XIX, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution.

It is ordered by the court that the Clerk shall serve a summons and a copy of the complaint on respondents as provided for by S.Ct.Prac.R 12.02.

It is further ordered that respondents shall file a response to the complaint no later than Thursday, December 2, 2021, by 4:00 p.m. If respondents file a dispositive motion, relators' response, if any, shall be filed no later than Friday, December 3, 2021, by 4:00 p.m.

It is further ordered by the court that relators' motion for scheduling order is granted and the following schedule is set for discovery, presentation of the evidence, and filing of briefs:

Discovery shall be complete no later than Wednesday, December 8, 2021; the parties shall file any evidence they intend to present no later than Friday, December 10, 2021, by 4:00 p.m.; relators shall file a brief no later than Monday, December 13, 2021, by 4:00 p.m.; respondents shall file a brief no later than Friday, December 17, 2021, by 4:00 p.m.; and relators may file a reply brief no later than Monday, December 20, 2021, by 4:00 p.m.

It is further ordered that the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio shall govern the procedure and form of documents filed in this action. The Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure shall supplement the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio for this case, unless clearly inapplicable.

It is further ordered that any disputes concerning discovery shall be addressed to the court by motion.

It is further ordered that no requests or stipulations for extension of time shall be filed and that the clerk of the court shall refuse to file any requests or stipulations for extension of time.
