**ORDER**

Having received the completed briefing on the Defendants' Motions for Summary Judgment (Doc. No. [141], Georgia State Conf. of the NAACP, et al. v. Georgia, 1:21-cv-5338-ELB-SCJ-SDG; Doc. No. [92], Common Cause, et al. v.

Raffensperger, 1:22-cv-90-ELB-SCJ-SDG), the Court deems it prudent to hold a hearing on these pending motions.

The hearing will be held *in person* on **May 30, 2023, at 10:00 AM** in **Courtroom No. 2306, in the Richard B. Russell Federal Building and United States Courthouse, 75 Ted Turner Drive, SW, Atlanta, Georgia 30303**. The Court will not permit counsel to argue via Zoom.

The argument will proceed as follows:

Plaintiffs will then have **30 Minutes, collectively**, to argue their responses to Defendants' Motions for Summary Judgment. Plaintiffs shall coordinate to allow for the efficient presentation of their arguments.
