## **ORDER**

Having received the completed briefing on the Defendants' Motions for Summary Judgment (Doc. No. [141], Georgia State Conf. of the NAACP, et al. v. Georgia, 1:21-cv-5338-ELB-SCJ-SDG; Doc. No. [92], Common Cause, et al. v. <u>Raffensperger</u>, 1:22-cv-90-ELB-SCJ-SDG), the Court deems it prudent to hold a hearing on these pending motions.
