ORDER DENYING MOTION TO INTERVENE

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on Motion to Intervene filed January 31, 2022, by Larry Marker, and the Court having reviewed the motion and responses of the various Defendants, and movant's replies, and being sufficiently advised, does hereby FIND:

- 1. This Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter herein.
- 2. Mr. Marker's motion requests intervenor status to protect his rights as a citizen of a county affected by the new congressional map at issue in this case.
- 3. Mr. Marker's requests mirror Plaintiffs' requests as to the ultimate goal of declaring the Congressional Map passed by the Legislature and signed by the Governor to be unconstitutional, albeit with slightly modified additional remedies.
- Mr. Marker suggests an additional cause of action under a separate section of the New Mexico Constitution, but without adequate supporting evidence.
- Mr. Marker's interests in this matter are adequately represented by the existing Plaintiffs.
 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Larry Marker's Motion to Intervene is denied.
