## <u>ORDER</u>

One of Defendants' Affirmative Defenses, as listed in the Pretrial Order, (Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., et al. v. Brad Raffensperger, 1:21-cv-5337- SCJ (N.D. Ga. Aug. 15, 2023) Doc. No. [280], 24; Coakley Pendergrass, et al. v. Brad Raffensperger, et al., 1:21-cv-5339-SCJ (N.D. Ga. Aug. 15, 2023) Doc. No. [231], 24; Annie Lois Grant, et al. v. Brad Raffensperger, et al., 1:22-cv-122-SCJ (N.D. Ga. Aug. 15, 2023) Doc. No. [243], 24) calls into question the constitutionality of Section 2 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 52 U.S.C. § 10301(b). Nothing in the record shows, however, that the additional notice of a constitutional question and service requirements of Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 5.1 have been met. Defendants are hereby ORDERED to promptly comply with the requirements of compliance with Rule 5.1 (on CM/ECF) on or before Tuesday, October 10, 2023.
