The court sets the following schedule for oral argument at 1:30 p.m. on Monday, May 16, 2022.


Appellants will argue first. The court grants Appellants 40 minutes for oral arguments; Appellants may reserve a portion of the time for rebuttal. See Supreme Court Rule 7.01(e)(3) (2022 Kan. S. Ct. R. at 41).

The court also grants Appellees 40 minutes for oral arguments. Under Rule 7.01(e)(5), Appellees must divide the allotted time among themselves by mutual agreement. The court directs Appellees to file written notice by noon on May 13, 2022, stating who will be presenting oral arguments and how Appellees will divide the time.

In light of Appellee Jamie Shew's Notice of Intent Not to File a Brief, the court will not permit Appellee Shew to present oral arguments. See Rule 7.01(e)(1).
