21 **SCHEDULING ORDER OF THE COURT**

22 The Court orders as follows:

23 1. The following deadlines are the dates by which the parties must electronically serve  
24 copies of the filing at issue on all other parties, and email the filing to this Court's judicial assistant.

25 Billie Shadron, at [BShadron@carson.org](mailto:BShadron@carson.org). Physical copies must be filed with the Court as soon as  
26 practicable thereafter, preferably first day following the deadline on which the clerk's office is  
27 open for filing.

28 2. Defendant and Intervenor shall have until **April 11, 2022**, at 5:00 p.m. PST, to

1 submit their respective responses to Plaintiff's previously-filed Memorandum in Support of the  
2 Complaint, limited to (10) pages, per FJDCR 3.23(b).

3 3. Plaintiff shall have until **April 22, 2022**, at 5:00 p.m. PST, to submit her optional  
4 reply brief, limited to five (5) pages, in support of her Memorandum in Support of the Complaint,  
5 per FJDCR 3.23(b).

6 4. Pursuant to First Judicial District Court Rule 3.10, the parties shall have until **April**  
7 **22, 2022**, at 5:00 p.m. PST, to submit proposed orders, with a cover sheet, that includes a statement  
8 of fact, applicable standard of law, analysis, and conclusions of law and order. The parties shall  
9 send to the Court and opposing counsel an electronic copy in Word, or some similar format.

10 5. Pursuant to First Judicial District Court Rule 3.11, Plaintiff shall file a Request for  
11 Submission after the filing of her reply brief.

12 6. The parties shall agree to electronic service of all documents amongst themselves,  
13 pursuant to NRCP 5(b)(2)(F).

14 7. The parties are reminded to comply with the Rules of Practice for the First Judicial  
15 District Court, including, but not limited to, Rule 3.2 that requires original signatures on all  
16 pleadings and papers.

17 8. The parties shall comply with F.J.D.C.R., including, but not limited to, Rule 3.2,  
18 requiring original signatures on all pleadings and papers. The Court, however, waives pre-hearing  
19 statements by the parties.

20 9. The Court shall schedule hearing on this matter, to be held in person or remotely,  
21 as the Court shall request, on April 25, 2022, at 3:00 P.m. PST.
