The Court orders as follows:

1. 2. Defendant and Intervenor shall have until **April 11, 2022**, at 5:00 p.m. PST, to submit their respective responses to Plaintiff's previously-filed Memorandum in Support of the Complaint, limited to (10) pages, per FJDCR 3.23(b).

3. Plaintiff shall have until **April 22, 2022**, at 5:00 p.m. PST, to submit her optional reply brief, limited to five (5) pages, in support of her Memorandum in Support of the Complaint, per FJDCR 3.23(b).

4. Pursuant to First Judicial District Court Rule 3.10, the parties shall have until **April 22, 2022**, at 5:00 p.m. PST, to submit proposed orders, with a cover sheet, that includes a statement of fact, applicable standard of law, analysis, and conclusions of law and order. The parties shall send to the Court and opposing counsel an electronic copy in Word, or some similar format.

5. Pursuant to First Judicial District Court Rule 3.11, Plaintiff shall file a Request for Submission after the filing of his reply brief.

6. The parties shall agree to electronic service of all documents amongst themselves, pursuant to NRCP 5(b)(2)(F).

7. The parties are reminded to comply with the Rules of Practice for the First Judicial District Court, including, but not limited to, Rule 3.2 that requires original signatures on all pleadings and papers.

8. The parties shall comply with FJDCR, including, but not limited to, Rule 3.2, requiring original signatures on all pleadings and papers. The Court, however, waives pre-hearing statements by the parties.

9. The Court shall schedule hearing on this matter, to be held in person or remotely, at the Court's discretion, on **April 25, 2022**, starting at 1:00 p.m. PST.
