2 RELATING TO BALLOTS; AMENDING CHAPTER 23, TITLE 18, IDAHO CODE, BY THE AD-3 DITION OF A NEW SECTION 18-2324, IDAHO CODE, TO PROHIBIT CERTAIN BALLOT 4 COLLECTION ACTIVITIES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 23, Title 18, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 18-2324, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 18-2324. BALLOT COLLECTION PROHIBITED -- EXCEPTIONS. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, a person may not knowingly collect or convey another voter's voted or unvoted ballot.
 - (2) This section does not apply to:
 - (a) An election official;
 - (b) A United States postal service worker or other individual specifically authorized by law to transmit United States mail in the performance of his official duties;
 - (c) An employee or contractor of a parcel delivery business that receives and delivers parcels in all states within the United States in the performance of his official duties;
 - (d) An individual related to the voter, whether by adoption, marriage, or blood, within the third degree of consanguinity; or
 - (e) An individual who is a member of the voter's household.
- (3) An individual authorized to collect and convey a voter's ballot pursuant to subsection (2) (d) of this section may not collect or convey more than six (6) such ballots at a time.
- (4) A violation of the provisions of this section constitutes a felony if the person was paid by anyone other than the voter to collect or convey the ballot or if the cumulative number of ballots collected or conveyed in violation of the provisions in this section is greater than ten (10). Any other violation of the provisions of this section constitutes a misdemeanor.
- SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.
