2. The temporary injunction set forth in this court's February 24, 2022 order, and clarified in a subsequent order issued on February 25, 2022, is terminated.

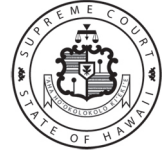
3. An opinion is forthcoming.
