

**THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**

**SUPREME COURT**

**In Case No. 2022-0184, Theresa Norelli & a. v. Secretary of State, the court on April 21, 2022, issued the following order:**

Having reviewed the Secretary of State’s statement regarding material facts, the court hereby joins the State of New Hampshire (the State) as a party. The name of the case is therefore changed to Theresa Norelli & a. v. Secretary of State & a. The Attorney General, as counsel for the State, see RSA 21-M:2 and :12-a, has already been served through the electronic filing system with each of the orders and filings in this case.

On or before April 22, 2022, the State shall provide written notification to this court as to whether it disputes the numerical entries in the table contained in ¶28 of the plaintiffs’ complaint. The table, which the complaint alleges is “generated from the P.L. 94-171 data files provided by the Census Bureau in 2010 and 2020,” is reproduced below.

District	2010 Population	2020 Population	Shift from 2010 to 2020	Deviation from Ideal 2020 Population	Percent Deviation
1	658,233	697,737	+39,504	+8,972	1.3%
2	658,237	679,792	+21,555	-8,973	-1.3%

If the State disputes any of those numerical entries, the State shall set forth its position as to the correct numerical entries.

In addition, on or before April 25, 2022, the State shall file a brief addressing each of the questions identified in section V of the court’s April 11, 2022 order.
