In order to minimize repetition across Non-U.S. Plaintiffs’ Oppositions to the Motions for Partial Summary Judgment filed by the Attorney General, State, and Intervenors, ECF Nos. 364, 367, 369, and Motions and Cross-Motions for Partial Summary Judgment, the Non-U.S. Plaintiffs have coordinated and divided the issues among them, with each plaintiff group addressing different issues in their briefing, and other groups joining that briefing where appropriate. To assist the Court in reviewing these filings, the Non-U.S. Plaintiffs have prepared charts, attached as Exhibit A, that identify each of the summary judgment issues addressed by Non-U.S. Plaintiffs thus far, and lists which of the Non-U.S. Plaintiffs join each of these arguments.

1 Because, in some cases, a Non-U.S. Plaintiff group joins less than all of the
2 arguments in a given brief, the charts are divided by issue, indicating in which brief
3 (identified by ECF number and the filing party) each argument can be found.
