**ORDER RECOGNIZING DISMISSAL OF SOME DEFENDANTS**

Plaintiffs have filed notices of voluntary dismissal without prejudice as to their claims against all defendants other than Secretary Laurel Lee. ECF Nos. 57, 58. The notices are effective without an order. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(i); *Plains Growers, Inc. v. Ickes-Braun Glasshouses, Inc.*, 474 F.2d 250, 253 (5th Cir. 1973) (“[A] plaintiff is entitled to a dismissal against one defendant under Rule 41(a), even though the action against another defendant would remain pending.”). This order confirms that the case has been dismissed against all defendants other than Secretary Laurel Lee. Future filings should omit the dismissed defendants from the case style.

The legislative parties’ motion to dismiss (ECF No. 50) is DENIED as moot.
