JOINT MOTION TO TEMPORARILY STAY PROCEEDINGS AND CONTINUE TRIAL

Plaintiffs Rosebud Sioux Tribe *et al.* and Defendants Steve Barnett *et al.* respectfully move the Court for a temporary stay of proceedings in this action until July 27, 2022, to permit the Parties sufficient time to complete ongoing settlement negotiations and to notify the Court whether a settlement has been reached. As the Parties advised the Court in the pretrial conference on June 26, 2022, and in their pending Joint Motion to Extend Settlement Deadline, ECF No. 122, the Parties are in advanced settlement negotiations, continue to make progress in those negotiations, and believe they will be able to determine whether a global settlement of Plaintiffs'

claims in this action can be reached soon. Accordingly, the Parties agree that a short stay of proceedings would be prudent and request that the Court continue the trial set to commence on July 12, 2022. If the Parties are unable to reach a settlement before the stay expires, the Parties agree to contact the Court promptly to request a new trial date.

The Parties respectfully request that the Court grant this motion and enter the attached proposed order.
