1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Katie Hobbs, in her official capacity as
2 Arizona Secretary of State, shall appear in person or through counsel before this Court on the
3 29th day of April, 2022, at the hour of 1:30 p.m. (2 hours allotted) at the Yavapai County
4 Superior Court located at 120 S. Cortez, Prescott, AZ 86303, Courtroom 301, then and there to
5 show cause why the requested relief should not be awarded.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs shall serve the Defendants within one (1)
9 business day of receipt of this order. Service may be effected by leaving a copy of the filings in
10 this case at Defendant's office, and emailing a copy to Defendant's Assistant Secretary of State
11 and General Counsel at their government email addresses.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff shall also serve the Governor's office within
13 one (1) business day of receipt of this order. Service may be effected by leaving a copy of the
14 filings in this case at the Governor's office, and emailing a copy to its government email
15 addresses.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant shall, by Wednesday, April 27, 2022, file a
18 response to Plaintiffs' Verified Petition for Special Action Relief and email a courtesy copy of
19 the response to Plaintiffs' counsel and to the Court at Div2@courts.az.gov.

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs shall, by Thursday, April 28, 2022, file a reply
21 in support of Plaintiffs' Verified Petition for Special Action Relief and email a courtesy copy of
22 the reply to Defendant's counsel and to the Court at Div2@courts.az.gov.
