ASSENTED TO MOTION TO DISMISS WITHOUT PREJUDICE

NOW COMES the appellant, New Hampshire Republican State Committee ("NHRSC"), and respectfully moves that this Honorable Court dismiss the above-captioned matter without prejudice, and states as follows in support thereof:

1. On April 21, 2023, the parties to this matter filed a joint motion asking this Court to remand the case to the superior court for consideration of a stipulation which, if granted, would render this matter moot.
2. By Order with a clerk's notice of decision dated May 3, 2023, the trial court approved the stipulation.
3. Accordingly, this matter is now moot and the Appellant moves to dismiss without prejudice.
