## ORDER

**AND NOW**, this 1<sup>st</sup> day of June, 2022, upon consideration of Plaintiffs' Motion for Temporary Restraining Order (ECF No. 2), and after holding a telephonic status conference, it is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

- Per agreement of the parties, Defendants Lehigh County Board of Elections and Northampton County Board of Elections are SPECIFICALLY DIRECTED not to finally certify the returns of the 2022 primary election during the pendency of this litigation.
- The Court will STAY consideration of Plaintiffs' request for Temporary Restraining Order in light of Defendants' agreement not to finally certify the election.
- 3. Defendants shall file Answers to the Complaint on or before **June 10, 2022.**
- Plaintiffs and Defendants shall each file simultaneous Motions for Summary Judgment and Briefs in Support on June 10, 2022. Motions for Summary Judgment shall be filed in accordance with Judge Gallagher's Policies and Procedures.

5. The parties shall file responsive briefs to the Motions for Summary Judgment on or before **June 17, 2022.**
