MUTUAL RELEASE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Mutual Release and Settlement Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into by and between, on one hand, Khary Penebaker, Mary Arnold, and Bonnie Joseph (collectively "Plaintiffs"), and, on the other hand, Andrew Hitt ("Hitt"), Robert F. Spindell, Jr. ("Spindell"), Bill Feehan ("Feehan"), Kelly Ruh ("Ruh"), Carol Brunner ("Brunner"), Edward Scott Grabins ("Grabins"), Kathy Kiernan ("Kiernan"), Darryl Carlson ("Carlson"), Pam Travis ("Travis"), and Mary Buestrin ("Buestrin") (Hitt, Spindell, Feehan, Ruh, Brunner, Grabins, Kiernan, Carlson, Travis, and Buestrin are collectively "Elector Defendants"). Plaintiffs and Elector Defendants shall be collectively referred to as the "Parties" and each, individually, as a "Party" to this Agreement.

1. Background. Elector Defendants, as nominated and/or replacement presidential electors for the Republican Party in Wisconsin in 2020, met and voted for Donald J. Trump and Michael R. Pence on December 14, 2020, because they were told that it was necessary to preserve their electoral votes in the event a court challenge may later change the outcome of the election in Wisconsin, and in compliance with requests initiated from the Trump campaign and the Republican Party of Wisconsin. The Plaintiffs allege that in doing so the Elector Defendants violated state and federal law and, furthermore, that the Plaintiffs, as well as other voters, taxpayers, and Democratic electors, have been harmed by such actions. The Elector Defendants dispute those allegations (the "Dispute"). The Plaintiffs commenced a lawsuit against the Elector Defendants and others alleging and asserting various claims related to the Dispute in Dane County Case No. 22-CV-1178 ("Lawsuit"), which is also the subject of an appeal and crossappeals, Appeal No. 23-AP-1985 ("Appeal"). The Parties participated in settlement discussions in November 2023 and reached an understanding as set forth in this Agreement. The Parties wish to forgo the time and expense of litigating these matters and wish to settle any and all claims the Parties may have against each other. The Parties, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this Agreement and for other good and valuable consideration, which is acknowledged, agree to the terms herein and to comply with the same.

2. <u>Elector Defendants' Agreement Related to Certain Activities</u>. In consideration and fulfillment of the promises exchanged, the Elector Defendants agree to the following:

- a. The Elector Defendants agree not to serve as presidential electors in 2024 or in any United States presidential election in which Donald J. Trump is on the ballot.
- b. The Elector Defendants agree to refrain from participating in any way in the execution or transmission of electoral votes in 2024 or in any United States presidential election in which Donald J. Trump is on the ballot.
- c. Regardless of whether Donald J. Trump is on the ballot, the Elector Defendants agree that with respect to all future United States presidential elections they will not participate in the execution or transmission of any document that purports to be a certificate of electoral votes of the duly elected presidential electors for the State of Wisconsin if, at the time of the execution or transmission, the persons voting have not been certified as the persons elected as presidential electors under Wisconsin law.
- d. The Elector Defendants agree to fully cooperate, or continue to cooperate, with any ongoing or future investigation or prosecution by the United States

Department of Justice regarding: (a) any efforts to interfere with the lawful transfer of power related to and following the 2020 presidential election; (b) any efforts to interfere with the certification of electoral votes during the Joint Session of Congress convened on January 6, 2021. Notwithstanding, this provision shall cease as to any Elector Defendant in the event such Elector Defendant becomes the target of any criminal investigation or prosecution by the United States Department of Justice; in such a circumstance, however, this provision shall continue in full force and effect as to all Elector Defendants who have not received notice that they have become targets in such a criminal investigation or prosecution.

- e. The Elector Defendants agree to fully cooperate with Plaintiffs in the litigation of this civil action against any remaining defendants on the condition that none of the Plaintiffs, their family members, heirs, or assigns bring any other claims against the Elector Defendants related to the 2020 presidential election.
- f. The Elector Defendants agree not to commit any violations of state or federal elections laws.

3. <u>Public Statement, Disclosure of Discovery Responses and Disclosure of</u> <u>Certain Documents Produced.</u>

a. The Elector Defendants will provide a public statement, set forth below, regarding the Dispute and will provide a copy of such statement to the President of the United States Senate, the Wisconsin Secretary of State, the Archivist of the United States, and the Chief Judge of the United States District Court for the Western District of Wisconsin. The public statement shall read as follows:

On December 14, 2020, in compliance with requests received from the Trump campaign and the Republican Party of Wisconsin, we met at the Wisconsin State Capitol and executed a document titled "Certificate of the Votes of the 2020 Electors from Wisconsin." That document stated, in part, that we were "the duly elected and qualified Electors for President and Vice President of the United States of America from the State of Wisconsin." The Elector Defendants took the foregoing action because they were told that it was necessary to preserve their electoral votes in the event a court challenge may later change the outcome of the election in Wisconsin. That document was then used as part of an attempt to improperly overturn the 2020 presidential election results.

The duly elected presidential electors for the State of Wisconsin for the 2020 presidential election were: Meg Andrietsch, Shelia Stubbs, Ronald Martin, Mandela Barnes, Khary Penebaker, Mary Arnold, Patty Schachtner, Shannon Holsey, Tony Evers, and Benjamin Wikler.

We hereby reaffirm that Joseph R. Biden, Jr. won the 2020 presidential election and that we were not the duly elected presidential electors for the State of Wisconsin for the 2020 presidential election.

We oppose any attempt to undermine the public's faith in the ultimate results of the 2020 presidential election.

We hereby withdraw the documents we executed on December 14, 2020, and request that

they be disregarded by the public and all entities to which they were submitted.

b. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, the Parties agree that they may disclose this Agreement and the written responses of any of the Elector Defendants to Plaintiffs' First Set of Interrogatories, Requests for Production of Documents, and Requests to Admit. Furthermore, the Parties agree that each may disclose or make public the other parties' respective production in response to Requests for Production of Documents as follows: see <u>Addendum C</u>, which redacts any e-mail addresses, residential addresses, and phone numbers, and redacts the names of certain private citizens who are not parties to this Lawsuit.

4. <u>Mutual No Contact.</u> The Elector Defendants agree not to intentionally contact, directly or indirectly, any of the Plaintiffs. Conversely, the Plaintiffs agree not to intentionally contact, directly or indirectly, any of the Elector Defendants. Nothing in this paragraph will preclude communications among the Parties' respective counsel when necessary or appropriate.

5. **Dismissal of Claims in Lawsuit.** Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the Plaintiffs agree to dismiss the claims asserted against the Elector Defendants in the Lawsuit with prejudice and without costs to either party and, furthermore, the Parties authorize their respective attorneys to electronically sign and file the stipulation to dismiss and to vacate the judgment against Plaintiff Bonnie Joseph, attached as <u>Addendum A</u> to this Agreement. Likewise, the Parties agree to dismiss the Elector Defendants from the Appeal and to dismiss the Elector Defendants' cross-appeal with prejudice and without costs to either party within ten (10) days after the Lawsuit is dismissed by the Dane County Circuit Court and, furthermore the Parties authorize their respective attorneys to electronically sign and file the stipulation attached as <u>Addendum B</u> to this Agreement.

6. <u>Related Proceedings.</u> Some counsel for the Plaintiffs also represent a complainant in an administrative complaint against the Elector Defendants, involving the same facts and similar claims at issue in the Lawsuit, in *Sickel v. Hitt et al.*, 2021 EL 21-13, now pending before the Wisconsin Elections Commission. Although the Plaintiffs are not parties to the administrative proceedings in *Sickel*, counsel for Mr. Sickel shall secure separate written agreement from Mr. Sickel that he will notify the Commission that he is withdrawing his complaint in the foregoing proceedings and, if the Commission declines to end the proceedings, Mr. Sickel will not appeal, petition for review of any Commission decision, and/or he will otherwise cooperate with the Elector Defendants to bring those proceedings to a prompt close, and take all steps in their power to, dismiss that complaint and end the proceedings.

7. <u>Mutual Release of All Claims</u>. In exchange for the consideration set forth herein and subject to the fulfillment of all other obligations set forth in this Agreement, each Party to this Agreement hereby releases the other Parties to this Agreement, along with the other Parties' respective agents, contractors, representatives, assigns, heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, employees, insurers, attorneys, and/or affiliates, and anyone else who might be liable, from any and all claims, actions, and demands whatsoever, that now exist or may hereafter accrue, for all losses, damages, injury, reimbursement, or otherwise that are based on the allegations and/or claims asserted, or that could have been asserted, in the Lawsuit. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this Section and the release herein do not include any claims stemming from or relating to a failure by a Party to comply with the obligations in this Agreement, which may be brought in the event that any Party breaches this Agreement.

8. <u>Costs</u>. The Plaintiffs and the Elector Defendants agree that the Parties will bear their own attorney's fees, costs, and expenses, and no financial award of any kind will be exchanged among them. The Elector Defendants agree not seek to execute the judgment of costs entered by Dane County Circuit Court Judge Frank Remington on November 22, 2023, against Plaintiff Bonnie Joseph. In addition, the Parties agree that they will jointly seek a vacatur of the judgment of costs entered by Judge Frank Remington on November 22, 2023, against Plaintiff Bonnie Joseph as part of the stipulated dismissal of the Lawsuit.

9. <u>No Admission of Liability</u>. The Plaintiffs acknowledge and agree that, by entering into this settlement, the Elector Defendants are not admitting any liability or culpability.

10. **No Additional Rights.** The Parties agree that they have entered into this Agreement for the purpose of resolving the Dispute among the Parties and for the benefit of the Parties. This Agreement is not intended to, and does not, give or create any rights other than those expressly stated herein and does not grant or create any rights to any third parties. The Parties further represent that they have not assigned or transferred any claims against the other Parties, or any rights they may have had to assert claims on behalf of the Parties. Likewise, the Parties represent that they have no present knowledge of any other individual, entity, or agency bringing claims against any Party concerning the Dispute or related to any claims asserted in the Lawsuit.

11. **Review of Agreement.** The Parties acknowledge that they are entering into this Agreement knowingly, voluntarily, and with full knowledge of its significance. The Parties, including their undersigned representatives, further represent and warrant that they are fully competent to enter into this Agreement, and that they have not received any advice or opinion from any health care provider or other professional that there are any legal or medical impediments to their competency to enter into this Agreement. The Parties further acknowledge that this Agreement was drafted mutually by the Parties and that their respective legal counsel have reviewed and approved the terms of this Agreement. Furthermore, in making this Agreement, it is understood and agreed that the Parties rely wholly upon their own or their counsel's judgment, belief, and knowledge of the Dispute, the Lawsuit, and information set forth herein, and this Agreement is made without reliance upon any other statement or representation by a Party or any other representations or warranties concerning or relating to any term in this Agreement.

12. <u>Governing Law</u>. The Parties acknowledge that this Agreement and all matters arising out of or relating to this Agreement, including tort and statutory claims are governed by the laws of Wisconsin, without giving effect to any conflict of laws provisions thereof that would result in the application of the laws of a different jurisdiction. The Parties agree that any dispute arising under this Agreement shall be venued exclusively in the Circuit Court for Dane County, Wisconsin.

13. **Entire Agreement.** This Agreement is fully integrated, contains all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement, and is the complete, final, and only understanding between the Parties with respect to its subject matter. This Agreement supersedes any and all prior agreements, negotiations, or understandings among the Parties, and all prior understandings, contracts, and/or agreements shall be void and unenforceable. No change or modification to this Agreement shall be binding on the Parties unless it is in writing and executed by all Parties.

14. **Enforceability.** If any one or more of the provisions of this Agreement shall be held invalid or unenforceable, such provisions shall be modified to the minimum extent necessary to make it or its application valid and enforceable, and in any event, the validity and enforceability of all other provisions of this Agreement shall not be affected.

15. <u>Assignment</u>. The Parties shall not assign any of their rights or delegate any of their obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of all other Parties. Any purported assignment or delegation in violation of this Section is null and void.

16. **Execution in Counterparts.** This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which is deemed an original, but all of which together are deemed to be one and the same agreement. A signed copy of this Agreement delivered by facsimile, email, or other means of electronic transmission is deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original signed copy of this Agreement.

17. <u>Acknowledgment</u>. The undersigned signors of this Agreement acknowledge as follows: that they have read and understand this Agreement and have fully agreed to each and every provision herein; that they have consulted with their respective legal counsel; and that the undersigned individuals have authority to enter into this Agreement.

Dear Grassroots Leaders,

Wisconsin's Republican electors met today, following statutory guidelines for presidential electors, preserving our role in the electoral process still under legal challenge. While President Trump's campaign continues to pursue legal options for Wisconsin, electors met in accordance with statutory guidelines to preserve our role in the electoral process with the final outcome still pending in the courts.

The 2020 election saw numerous violations of both the letter and the spirit of Wisconsin law. Hello 3rd District Leaders,

As many of you know by now a lawsuit naming the Wisconsin Elections Commission was filed in my name yesterday by Sidney Powell's law firm. I am not an expert on voting systems or statistical analysis so that part of the complaint is something that I cannot say is valid or that it will succeed. What I can say with absolute certainty is that the Democrat Chair of the elections commission and WEC staff clearly violated Wisconsin state law in their directions to clerks pertaining to "indefinitely confined elector status" and curing ballots that were not properly filled out. That is over 96,000 illegal ballots for indefinitely confined electors.

During the recount Democrat election officials refused to honor challenges to ballots that had been "cured." There is no way of knowing how many of those ballots were cast.

Democrats on the WEC refused to remove voters who were flagged by the ERIC system from the Wisconsin voting rolls. Chair's Report – December 2020

On Monday, December 14th, at noon I cast my ballot as an Elector representing the 2nd Congressional District for President Trump and Vice President Pence. We did this at the state capitol as prescribed by law and it is in the hands of Congress right now.

Proposed Jim Troupis Statement on Electors Meeting

"As the legal proceedings continue to work their way through the Wisconsin court system, I have advised the Republican Party of Wisconsin to convene a separate Republican electors meeting and vote at the Wisconsin State Capitol on December 14.

Of course, there is precedent for such a meeting. Democrats convened in Hawaii in 1960, at the same time as Republicans, even though the Governor had certified Richard Nixon as the winner. In the end, the state's electoral votes were ultimately awarded to President Kennedy. In fact, just last month, when Republicans appeared to have a lead in Pennsylvania, Larry Lessig and Van Jones published an essay on <u>CNN.com</u> calling on Democrats to possibly convene their electors in that state if the results were still in doubt. Given this, and the legal arguments that have yet to be decided, the GOP electors should also meet on Monday while we await a final resolution in Wisconsin."

[Note: this is Word Doc # 1 of 6]

Before the Meeting of Electors:

--Jim Troupis, the lead attorney for the Wisconsin state-court litigation, plans to issue a press release along the lines of **Doc # 2**. Likely he will release it by Sat., Dec. 12.

--Carefully check **Doc # 5**, **Certificate of the Votes** (for names of electors, and decide who will be the chairperson & secretary; current draft is merely a suggestion).

--Once finalized, print out eight (8) copies of Doc # 5 (preferably on high-quality paper).

--Print out Docs # 4-A and # 4-B, the ballots for the Electors.

--Prepare external mailing envelopes, and prepaid postage, large enough to send the Certificates, without bending them, addressed to the four addresses listed on **Doc #** 6. Note that two of the items <u>must</u> be sent by <u>Registered</u> (not Certified) mail.

--Prepare somewhat smaller internal envelopes, and have tape on hand to use to seal them tightly. On the face of the envelopes, tape paper (or use large adhesive labels) reading, in large, bolded type.

OF THE UNITED STATES

(It's important that this internal envelope be <u>sealed</u>, and <u>clearly labeled</u>. This is the envelope that will not be opened until January 6, in Congress.)

--Have the chairperson sign, in advance, eight (8) duplicate originals of **Doc # 6** (cover memo). Place these & the internal envelopes in the 4 external envelopes.

--Also prepare an external FedEx envelope addressed to the Trump Campaign. Place the 2 extra cover memos in that envelope.

Page 2 of 2 HOW TO CAST ELECTORAL VOTES IN WISCONSIN

For the Meeting of Electors:

-- Under Wisconsin law, the electors "shall meet at the state capitol," which presumably means in the Capitol Building, "at 12:00 noon." Wis. Stat. § 7.75(1) (here).

--There is no requirement that the Electors meet in public, and a private meeting (perhaps with press coverage) might be preferable to avoid protest disruptions. See <u>this video</u> on the Wisconsin protests against the Trump-Pence Electors in 2016.

--Chairperson should call the meeting to order and determine if all Electors are in attendance.

--If there are any vacancies, the Electors in attendance vote to fill the vacancy, using forms in **Doc # 3** (thus, important to have a laptop and printer on hand to complete and print out the forms).

--If there are any vacancies, **Doc # 5** must be amended, and eight (8) new duplicate originals need to be printed out, accurately listing all Electors in attendance.

--All Electors then sign two (2) ballots **Docs # 4-A** and **# 4-B** -- casting ballots for President and Vice President, separately. If there are replacement Electors, they should sign using one of the blank forms at the end of each Word file.

(Note: these ballots are not to be sent to Washington; but they should be retained as proof that the Electors did actually cast ballots for President & Vice President.)

--All Electors sign all eight (8) originals of the Certificate of the Votes (Doc # 5).

Following the Meeting of Electors:

--If there were vacancies filled, staple copies of the vacancy forms (**Doc # 3**) to each of the eight (8) duplicate originals of the Certificate of the Vote.

--Place six (6) of the duplicate originals in the four envelopes that were prepared (as indicted on the cover memo), and mail them as indicated, by Registered & Certified Mail. FedEx the remaining two (2) duplicate originals to the Trump Campaign.

3. I understand as a state legislator that I have a duty under the Electors Clause of Article II of the United States Constitution to vote on post-election certification of the Presidential electors to choose the President and Vice President on January 6, 2021—a date set by 3 U.S.C. § 15.
