Nilsestuen, presiding, in favor of (Name of party opposing appeal) Plaintiff League of Women Voters of Wisconsin, and against (Name of party filing appeal) Intervenor-Defendant Wisconsin State Legislature, wherein the court (Describe judgment or order) in a decision and order issued on January 2, 2024, granted Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment as to Count 2 of Plaintiff's Second Amended Complaint, denied Defendant Wisconsin Election Commission's cross motion for summary judgment as to Count 2 of Plaintiff's Second Amended Complaint, and denied Intervenor-Defendant Wisconsin State Legislature's motion for summary judgment as to Count 2 of Plaintiff's Amended Complaint, and, in a final declaratory judgment and permanent injunction issued on January 30, 2024, ordered that Wisconsin election officials may not reject certain absentee ballots that fail to comply with Wisconsin's absentee-ballot witness requirement, see Wis. Stat. s. 6.87(6d), due to 52 U.S.C. s. 10101(a)(2)(B). This Notice Of Appeal covers all prior orders from the Circuit Court.
