ORDER DENYING TEMPORARY INJUNCTION

A hearing was held on October 7, 2022 on Plaintiffs' Motion for a Temporary Injunction. I considered the parties' briefs and supporting materials and oral arguments. Based upon the facts and reasons stated on the record, the court finds that the definition of an absentee ballot witness "address" contained in the October 18, 2016 Wisconsin Elections Commission memorandum and the September 14, 2022 memorandum to clerks from the Elections Commission, namely that an address is sufficient if it contains a street number, street name and name of municipality, is the status quo and that the requested temporary injunction is unnecessary to preserve the status quo.

THEREFORE, the Motion for a Temporary Injunction is DENIED.
