

- The Decision and Order of the Saratoga County Supreme Court should be affirmed;
- The provisions of Chapter 763 of the Laws of 2021 should be declared to be unconstitutional in all respects;
- The Decision and Order of the Saratoga County Supreme Court should be modified to declare Chapter 2 of the Laws of 2022 to be unconstitutional for the reasons stated by that Court;
- The Preservation Order issued by the Court below should be affirmed and allowed to stand in full force and effect;
- All temporary relief granted to the Appellants should be vacated and denied; and

- The motion by the proposed intervenors to be made parties to this Appeal should be denied.
