Upon the application of the Petitioner herein, the Court having conferred the case this date, it is hereby:

**ORDERED**, that all preparations relating to the mandatory hand count of the ballots cast in the 50<sup>th</sup> Senate District shall immediately be halted and suspended by the respondent Boards of Elections, and it is

**ORDERED**, that pending the further order of this Court, the Respondent Boards of Elections are hereby enjoined from sorting handling or in any way removing ballots associated with the election for State Senate in the 50<sup>th</sup> Senate District from any of the secured voting containers that they were returned to the Board of Elections in (or that were returned with the voting machines) used on the days of early voting or the day of the election, and it is further

**ORDERED**, that pending the further order of this Court, the Respondent Boards of Elections, in cases where the ballots of this election have been removed from the voting machines and / or further removed from the secured containers in those machines, such ballots

shall be sealed securely on a bipartisan basis, and said Boards are hereby enjoined from sorting handling or in any way removing ballots associated with the election for State Senate in the 50<sup>th</sup> Senate District from any envelopes so secured, that they are / may have been stored in.


