**ORDER TO SUSPEND THE

The Motion of Plaintiffs to Suspend the Destruction of Election Materials came on for review by the Court [by hearing/by written submission of the parties] by the Honorable [Judge].

3. Defendant shall within thirty (30) days reimburse Plaintiff's motion filing fee of \$75 and attorney fees of \$1,120.00.

4. The parties shall submit a joint discovery plan and proposed scheduling order within 10 days of the date of this order.
