EMERGENCY PETITION FOR PEREMPTORY JUDGMENT AND SUMMARY, DECLARATORY AND INJUNCTIVE RELIEF

- 1. Pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1098 and Luzerne County Local Rule of Civil Procedure 1098, Plaintiff, Jim Bognet, asks that this Court enter peremptory judgment granting Plaintiff's claim for a writ of mandamus and enter summary relief granting Plaintiff's claim for declaratory and injunctive relief.
- 2. The requested relief is warranted because there are no material factual disputes and Plaintiffs' right to a writ of mandamus and declaratory and injunctive relief is clear as a matter of law. MFW Wine Co., LLC v. Pennsylvania Liquor Control Bd., 231 A.3d 50, 52 n.2 & 56 (Pa. Commw. 2020) (describing the standard that governs both peremptory judgment and summary relief); Thomas v. Com., Bd. of Prob. & Parole, 699 A.2d 792, 795 (Pa. Commw. 1997) (same).
- 3. The Election Code requires boards of election to complete reconciliation process during the canvass and prior to certification of the election results. 25 P.S. § 3154(b)–(d), (f).

- 4. During the 2022 General Election, several polling locations in Luzerne County experienced a paper shortage and ran out of ballot paper on November 8, 2022.
- 5. The Luzerne County Board of Elections has not completed the mandatory reconciliation process for the November 8, 2022 General Election.
 - 6. Plaintiffs request expedited consideration of this motion.
- 7. In support of this motion, Plaintiff relies on the contemporaneously filed brief in support and his complaint, which is incorporated by reference. A proposed Order is attached.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests that this Honorable Court order the following relief:

- 1. Issue a writ of mandamus compelling the Board to complete the reconciliation process for the 2022 General Election prior to certifying the results of the election under 25 P.S. § 3154(f);
- 2. Issue a declaratory judgment that the Board may not forego any aspect of the reconciliation process as set forth in 25 P.S. § 3154; and
- 3. Issue an injunction prohibiting the Board from certifying the results of the election until it has completed the reconciliation process; and
 - 4. Grant such further relief as may be necessary or appropriate.
