Counselors, the Court has been advised that the manual recounts have been completed by the Boards of Elections, and that there are objections for which the candidates are seeking judicial review. A hearing on the objections will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, December 14, 2022, in the Onondaga County Supreme Court, continuing through Friday, December 16, 2022, as necessary. This hearing is an open session of the Court, and personal appearances are required. If an attorney needs to appear remotely, please contact chambers to discuss arrangements. All other individuals must appear in person.

The Respondent Boards of Elections are directed to present the objected ballots in a secure and bipartisan manner to the Onondaga County Supreme Court Clerks Office to have them marked as exhibits by 9:00 a.m. on the morning of Wednesday, December 14, 2022. Please complete the marking of all exhibits prior to the hearing.

The Respondents Boards of Elections shall also, as soon as practicable upon request in advance of the hearing, provide the parties counsel with photocopies of the ballots that have been objected to.

Counsel for the parties may, if they want, file hearing briefs with respect to their legal arguments on the validity of the ballots that have been objected to the NYSCEF system (in both actions) no later than noon on Tuesday, December 13, 2022.
