



DUTIES PERTAINING TO ANY ELECTION RECORDS. ALL SUCH ELECTION RECORDS MUST NOT BE DESTROYED, TAMPERED WITH, OR MANIPULATED IN ANY MANNER. THE COURT'S REFERENCE TO ELECTION RECORDS INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, THE CATEGORIES LISTED BELOW:

1. All election supplies, as that term is defined in Section 51.001 of the Texas Election Code (e.g., "the equipment, ballots, forms, lists of registered voters, and other materials necessary to conduct an election");
2. All precinct election records, as that term is defined in Section 66.002 of the Texas Election Code (e.g., "precinct election returns, voted ballots, and other records of an election that are assembled and distributed");
3. The election day vote totals cast by precinct, as that term is defined in Section 66.0021 of the Texas Election Code (e.g., "list that states the total number of votes cast in each precinct by personal appearance on election day");
4. The envelopes as defined in Section 66.003 (e.g., "Envelope No. 1, No. 2, No. 3 and No. 4"), as well as the contents of those envelopes as defined in Section 66.022, 66.023, 66.024, and 66.0241 of the Texas Election Code (e.g., "Contents of Envelope No. 1, No. 2, No. 3 and No. 4");

5. The contents of ballot box number 3 and 4, as that term is defined in Section 66.025 and 66.026, respectively (e.g., “Contents of Ballot Box No. 3 and Contents of Ballot Box No. 4”);
6. Electronic records created under Chapter 129 of the Texas Election Code, and as further described by Section 66.058 of the Texas Election Code;
7. Rotating ballot boxes number 1 and 2, as defined in Section 65.003 of the Texas Election Code (e.g., “Rotating Ballot Boxes No. 1 and No. 2”);
8. All provisional ballot affidavits;
9. All provisional ballots remaining inside of provisional ballot affidavits;
10. All mail-in ballot applications;
11. All mail-in ballot envelopes;
12. All mail-in ballots remaining inside of mail-in ballot envelopes;
13. All statements of residency;
14. All limited ballot applications;
15. All limited ballots;
16. All ADA reports for all polling locations during early voting and also during election day voting;
17. All turnout reports;
18. All tally reports;
19. All chain of custody documents or reports;

20. All documents regarding the supply of ballot paper or other supplies or equipment;
21. All call logs maintained by the Harris County Elections Administrator during election day; and
22. Any and all other documents, equipment, supplies or records arising out of the November 8, 2022 General Election in Harris County.
