Without repeating Yavapai County's arguments, Pinal County is of the same view that Plaintiffs' request for images of early voter signatures should be denied. Pinal County has the same, if not to a greater extent due the greater volume of ballots (109,341 early ballots cast in Pinal County) that would need to be imaged in an extremely tight timeframe. Thus, Pinal County has the same concerns as expressed by Yavapai County defendants. Pinal County requests the Court take judicial notice of Pinal County's General Canvass, at https://apps.azsos.gov/election/files/2022 General Canvass Pinal.pdf (at page 4).

In addition, Pinal County Defendants likewise have not "pre-sorted" or categorized all 145,600 ballots cast in Pinal County in a manner that would facilitate the requested inspection sought by Plaintiff's without certain logistical and mangower challenges.

Finally, any inspection, should it be permitted, must comply with the §A.R.S 16-677(A) in order to preserve the integrity of the process and security of the ballots which includes a three person panel, filing of a petition bond and having the inspection performed in the presence of the legal custodian of the ballots.
