If the parties cannot agree on a district map, each shall file their proposal with the Court on or before November 8, 2021. The Court will hold a hearing on November 15, 2021, at 2:30 ~~am~~ ^{pm} when the Court will consider and adopt appropriate relief, including a district map, in time for implementation before the next county elections.
