ORDER ALLOWING PLAINTIFFS TO AMEND

Attorney General Lynn Fitch, in her official capacity as Attorney General of the State of Mississippi, and the State of Mississippi, ex rel. Governor of the State of Mississippi, Tate Reeves, in his official capacity as Governor of Mississippi, and the Defendants, the State of Mississippi, ex rel. Attorney General Lynn Fitch and the Honorable Michael K. Randolph, in his official capacity as Chief Justice of the Mississippi Supreme Court, oppose the Plaintiffs' Motion to Amend, and this Court, after having

considered the Defendants' Motion and argument against allowing the Plaintiffs to amend their Complaint, finds the Plaintiffs shall be allowed to amend their Complaint to add the Defendants mentioned in this Order of Amendment.
