SCHEDULING ORDER

The Court sets the following deadlines for remedial proceedings in this case:

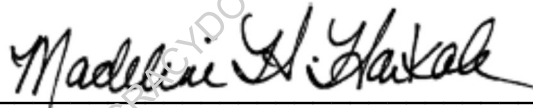
- **Filing Parties' Remedial Plans:** The Commission may file a remedial plan. The Commission shall submit a description of that plan and any evidence or arguments demonstrating that such plan complies with the Constitution and federal law, including Section 2 of the VRA, **by October 6**. Plaintiffs may also submit up to 2 proposed remedial plans as well as supporting briefs and evidence **by October 6**.

- **Objections to Parties' Remedial Plans:** The parties may file objections with evidence to the remedial plans offered by **October 14**.
- **Replies in Support of Parties' Remedial Plans:** The parties may file replies with evidence in support of the remedial plans offered by **October 15**.

At this time, the Court does not believe that it is necessary to appoint a special master in this proceeding, but the Court will reconsider its decision if it learns new information that indicates a special master will be helpful.

If the Court requires a hearing, the hearing will take place on **October 20, 2025** at **10:00 a.m.** in **Courtroom 4B** of the **Hugo L. Black Courthouse, Birmingham, AL**.
