An act to add Section 19207.5 to the Elections Code, relating to elections. elections, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 969, as amended, Pellerin. Elections: voting systems.

Existing law authorizes the governing board of a local jurisdiction to adopt a voting system for use in an election if the system has been certified or conditionally approved by the Secretary of State.

This bill would prohibit a county board of supervisors from terminating an existing voting system contract without a transition plan and a replacement contract in place.

This bill would declare that it is to take effect immediately as an urgency statute.

Vote: majority $\frac{2}{3}$. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 19207.5 is added to the Elections Code,
to read:

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1 19207.5. A county board of supervisors shall not terminate an

existing voting system contract without a transition plan and a 2 3 replacement contract in place.

SEC. 2. This act is an urgency statute necessary for the 4

immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety within 5

the meaning of Article IV of the California Constitution and shall 6

go into immediate effect. The facts constituting the necessity are: 7

8 In order to ensure that county elections officials know what

9 voting system they will be using, particularly with the upcoming 2024 March Presidential Primary, it is necessary for this act to

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11 take effect immediately.

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
