ORDER DIRECTING BRIEFING

The Court convened an evidentiary hearing in this case on April 28, 2026. During the hearing, the parties made extensive arguments as to the impact of the *Louisiana v. Callais* case then-pending at the Supreme Court. Today, the Supreme Court issued its decision in *Callais*. In light of the same, the parties shall each file a Memorandum articulating their respective position as to the impact of *Callais* on this case and how this Court should proceed with the remedial process. The parties shall do so no later than Wednesday, May 6, 2026.¹
