Pending before the Court are Defendants' Motion to Stay Proceedings Pending Interlocutory Appeal, (Doc. No. 130), and Plaintiffs' response in opposition, (Doc. No. 134). The Court finds that a reply would be helpful in resolving the pending motion. Accordingly, on or before June 1, 2023, Defendants shall file a reply, not to exceed 10 pages in length, in support of their motion. In their reply, Defendants shall respond to Plaintiffs' arguments that:

- (1) Defendants' Rule 23(f) petition is unlikely to be granted, (Doc. No. 134 at 5-8);
- (2) Defendants have not shown irreparable harm absent a stay, (id. at 14-15);
- (3) the parties agreed, after receiving the Court's ruling on class certification, that fact discovery will close on May 28, 2023, (*id.* at 2, 16); and
- (4) a stay would cause substantial harm to others, (id. at 16).

It is so **ORDERED**.
