Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(c), Defendant Brad Johnson in his official capacity as Anoka County Attorney moves for judgment on the pleadings. As more fully set forth in the accompanying Memorandum of Law, Johnson is entitled to judgment on the pleadings because newly-enacted Minnesota Statute § 211B.075 does not violate the First Amendment to the United States Constitution and otherwise passes constitutional muster. Because Section 211B.075 is constitutional both facially and as applied to Plaintiffs, the claims set forth in Plaintiffs' Amended Complaint fail as a matter of law.

Johnson's motion is based on the accompanying Memorandum of Law, the Declaration of Jason Stover with attached exhibits, Plaintiffs' Amended Complaint, and all the files and proceedings herein.
