PETITION CONTESTING ELECTION

NOW INTO COURT comes Petitioner, John Nickelson (hereinafter "Petitioner"), who respectfully represents as follows:

INTRODUCTION ROUTE TO MINUTE CLERK

1.

This is an election contest of Defendant Henry Whitehorn's putative one-vote margin in the November 18, 2023, election for Caddo Parish Sheriff. The result of that election will need to be determined by this Court: the evidence will show that the 2023 Caddo Parish general election is tainted with dubious votes, irregularities, and a lack of procedure which necessitates review.

PARTIES, JURISDICTION, AND VENUE

2.

Made defendants herein are Henry Whitehorn, an adult resident of the Parish of Caddo Parish and a candidate for Sheriff of Caddo Parish, who is a proper party defendant pursuant to La. R.S. §18:1402(B)(1)(c) and R. Kyle Ardoin, in his official capacity as Secretary of State for the State of Louisiana, who is a proper party defendant pursuant to La. R.S. §18:1402(C).

3.

Petitioner is a proper party plaintiff pursuant to La. R.S. §18:1402(B)(2) as he is a qualified elector domiciled in Parish of Caddo, a candidate for Sheriff, Caddo Parish, and did vote in the election which occurred on November 18, 2023.

4.

Jurisdiction and venue are proper in this Court. La. R.S. §18:1404.

THE ELECTION

5.

Louisiana Constitution Article XI states that the Louisiana Legislature should provide for in person and absentee balloting, and an election code and a process for contesting elections.

6.

A general election was held on November 18, 2023, for the elected office of Sheriff of Caddo Parish, State of Louisiana (hereinafter, the "Election").

7.

That election was between Petitioner Nickelson and Defendant Whitehorn, who were the top-two vote-getting candidates in the October 14, 2023, primary election for Sheriff.

8.

Unofficial returns for the Election revealed that the election was purportedly decided by a single vote. **See Exhibit A.** Out of 43,241 votes cast, Whitehorn allegedly received 21,621 votes compared to Nickelson's 21,620 votes, as reported by the Secretary of State:

9.

However, the process for the tabulation of certain mail-in and absentee ballots, as well as in-person voting, revealed several irregularities that call the results into serious question.

IN-PERSON VOTING

10.

An initial investigation has revealed that there were even more irregularities with in-person voting, absentee voting and mail-in voting, all of which impacted the outcome of the Election.

11.

The apparent errors in the in-person voting process occurred across Caddo Parish and are well-documented in public records.

12.

As described in Exhibit A *in globo*, and incorporated herein by reference, the irregularities are significant, and any single one of them could have, and likely did, affect the margin in this Election.

13.

In one egregious example, in Precinct 103 and Precinct 109 two voters whose names are filed under seal (*See Exhibit B*) voted twice: both in person on Election Day and by mail.

14.

Examples of other irregularities, which are enunciated herein as illustrative and not exhaustive, include multiple machines casting votes for two voters, individuals who were unable to vote specifically for Sheriff in the Election, and still other irregularities which can and did affect the outcome of this Election.

15.

In Precinct 8, two votes registered for one voter after casting a ballot, which could have affected the outcome of the Election.

16.

In Precincts 9, 90B, 91A, and 105, the total number of votes registered did not match the total number of voters casting ballots according to the list of voters completed by the poll workers, any one of which could have affected the outcome of the Election.

17.

In Precincts 13, 43, 44, and 48 voters specifically reported issues voting for sheriff and had specific questions as to whether their votes for sheriff were counted.

18.

Even more precincts reflect, via the error reports, that voters had a difficult time determining whether their votes were counted. *See Exhibit A*.

19.

These reports, at a minimum, affected the outcome of this Election. Given the 1-vote margin currently reflected, all ballots and irregularities should be reviewed by this Honorable Court.

20.

As an additional illustrative example, two voters who are known to the Plaintiff and volunteered this information stated that they were unable to properly register votes for the Petitioner at Blanchard Elementary, Ward 00/Precinct 136B, and that poll workers informed voters there they had been dealing with votes not registering throughout election day.

21.

One of those voters freely admitted and/or told poll workers on election day that they voted twice. Another was noted by poll workers comparing the list of voters to the list of absentee voters.

22.

Those two additional votes could have changed the outcome of this Election. The additional votes are unlawful, a substantial irregularity, and clear error.

23.

A review of public records has revealed that at least four individuals under orders of interdiction voted in this Election. Their names are also filed herein under seal (*See Exhibit B*).

24.

Those four additional votes could have changed the outcome of this Election. The additional votes are unlawful, a substantial irregularity, and a clear error.

25.

Attached as Exhibit C is the affidavit of a voter who has voted in the same precinct for 15 years was unable to vote because the precinct had no record of his voter registration.

26.

Despite making several phone calls to the local and state officials that he hoped could help him cast his ballot, was not able to vote – and was not (at any time) told that he could, despite the paperwork, cast a provisional ballot in the very same precinct where he had been voting for the previous decade-plus. Exhibit C.

27.

This voter attempted to call the registrar to discern why he was not allowed to vote, but was told only that he would be allowed to register later. Neither state nor local officials have any explanation for this man's trouble voting. *Id.*

28.

If he had been provided the opportunity to cast a provisional ballot, his vote would have resulted in a different outcome in this Election. *Id.*

29.

On information and belief, there are other voters such as the foregoing who were unable to vote and/or not provided a provisional ballot, any of which could have caused a different outcome in this Election. The Registrar's failure to offer a provisional ballot or other accommodation to a voter who had voted in the same precinct for more than a decade is a substantial irregularity which would have resulted in a different outcome to this election in this case alone.

30.

On information and belief, other bad acts, including the "giveaway" of things of value paid for with public funds affected the outcome of this Election and must be reviewed by this Court.

31.

Petitioner has been informed that certain poll workers directed voters to a giveaway funded with taxpayer dollars from the Caddo Parish Commission held nearby at the Caddo Parish Early Start Center, where voters were provided food by individuals in "Whitehorn for Sheriff" shirts.

32.

On information and belief, public funds were improperly and unlawfully used to influence voters in casting their ballots for the Defendant in this Election. This type of unlawful influence is substantially irregular and could very well have been the difference in the outcome of this Election.

MAIL AND ABSENTEE VOTING

33.

In the Election, 7,781 absentee by mail ballots were collected, according to the Clerk of Court. They were recounted on November 27, 2023.

34.

Petitioner is aware of at least six (6) voters who are listed as having voted absentee by mail but are also, according to public records, deceased as of election day. Any of these (or all of them) affected the outcome of the Election. Their names are filed under seal (*See Exhibit B*).

35.

Further, the Petitioner is aware of at least two individuals, in Precinct 103 and 109, as noted *supra*, who voted twice, including by absentee by mail ballot.

36.

Petitioner is also aware that 51 duplicate ballots were cast, in which the Board of Elections copies a ballot which it deems to be rejected in order to obtain the intent of the voter. These 51 "duplicate" ballots should be reviewed and adjudicated by this Court.

37.

Petitioner has noted several irregularities which, ordinarily, would not affect the outcome of the Election. However, in this case, Petitioner believes that he would have been elected Sheriff if not for those irregularities which are likely to have affected the outcome.

38.

In opening and counting the absentee by mail ballots, the Caddo Parish Board of Election Supervisors utilized two machines and a Scantron-like ballot reading system that has a margin of error reflecting the need for a hand recount, and a machine recount is not sufficient to determine the outcome of this Election.

39.

In opening and counting these ballots, the Caddo Parish Board of Election Supervisors, on information and belief, did not properly adjudicate ballots with distinguishing marks or other features susceptible of identification in accordance with the law. Certain ballots which were marked were not removed. Further, other ballots were deemed in need of copying or duplicating and approximately 51 ballots were "duplicated" and run through the scanner for counting.

40.

On information and belief, the Caddo Parish Board of Election Supervisors counted absentee by mail ballots which had been witnessed by individuals who witnessed more than one ballot completed by someone other than an immediate family member, in violation of La. R.S. §18:1306(E)(2)(a). Those names, obtained by a 90-minute cursory review, reveal numerous ballots which are not in compliance with the law and which were counted.

41.

At the recount on November 27, 2023, the Board of Election Supervisors adjudicated multiple ballots using a computerized system. The number of ballots counted increased by 6, but the margin between the candidates was unaffected.

42.

On information and belief the Board utilized a system in an attempt to find "voter intent," and compensated for undervotes, overvotes and other distinguishing marks, in addition to creating the duplicate ballot issue noted *supra*.

43.

Louisiana law states that ballots with any distinguishing mark or "any feature making the ballot susceptible of identification" that was placed on the ballot by the voter "shall be rejected."

44.

On information and belief, this did not occur, and ballots that included initials, names or other distinguishing marks or other features making the ballots susceptible of identification were counted in this Election.

45.

Attached hereto as Exhibit D is the Affidavit of Creighton Light, the Republican Designee on the Caddo Parrish Board of Election Supervisors, who details that the Board did not follow the law regarding the review of absentee by mail ballots for distinguishing marks, and that the scanning machines are not as reliable as a hand recount.

46.

Given the affidavit from a person with significant knowledge on the subject, a hand recount would be the only appropriate way to ensure that a single vote margin was the difference.

47.

Petitioner has requested a recount of the absentee and mail-in ballots, however, the Caddo Parish Board of Election Supervisors met and declined to conduct a hand recount despite concerns over the adjudication of ballots. Petitioner is concerned about the supposed adjudication of ballots.

48.

In an interview November 21, 2023, with KSLA-TV in Shreveport, the Clerk of Court stated that at the recount to occur November 27, 2023, the Board of Election Supervisors would be reviewing ballots by mechanical recount. No hand recount occurred on November 27, 2023.

49.

The margin of error on mechanical recounts is significant, and a hand recount, in an Election with a margin of 1 vote, is essential.

50.

Further, the Clerk of Court stated in that interview that the board of Election supervisors intends to adjudicate ballots again at the recount set for November 27, 2023: for any votes that are not capable of being recounted by machine, he said, "we will look at it by hand, adjudicate it, and make the decision as to what the intent of the voter was."²

51.

As noted *supra*, Exhibit D (Affidavit of Light) makes clear that the margin of error and processes were outweighed by a concern for the holidays. The Petitioner wishes to have a hand recount and should not be denied an accurate result by the calendar.

52.

These comments and other information available to the Petitioner make clear that the Board of Election Supervisors did not properly review the absentee by mail ballots as required by law on Election day. See La. R.S. §18:1313.

53.

That law requires that the Board perform an exhaustive process in tabulating absentee by mail ballots. The relevant portions of La. R.S. §18:1313 state that the Board of Election Supervisors is to follow a specific process for reviewing, tabulating, and rejecting ballots:

G. The procedure for the preparation, verification, counting, and tabulation of absentee by mail ballots shall be as follows:

(1) A member of the board shall remove the certificates and special absentee by mail ballots and envelopes containing the absentee by mail ballots from the special absentee by mail and early voting ballot envelope or container.

(2) The board shall announce the name of each absentee by mail voter and the ward and precinct where he is registered to vote, and shall compare the name on the certificate or on the flap of the envelope containing the absentee by mail ballot with the names on the absentee by mail voter report.

(3) The board shall determine the validity of challenges filed in accordance with R.S.18:1315.

(4) If the board determines that an absentee by mail ballot is valid, a member of the board shall make a check mark on the absentee by mail voter report beside the name of the voter as it appears on the report and write his initials on each page of the report. If applicable, a member of the board shall tear the flap from the envelope containing the absentee by mail ballot and leave the envelope sealed.

(5) If a majority of the members of the board determine that an absentee by mail ballot is invalid, the members shall leave the flap on the envelope containing the absentee by mail ballot, leave the envelope sealed, and a member of the board shall write the word "rejected", together with the reasons for rejecting the ballot, across the envelope containing the ballot or across the certificate attached to the special absentee by mail ballot. He shall also write the word "rejected" and his initials on the absentee by mail voter report beside the name of the voter as it appears in the report. The rejected absentee by mail ballots and certificates shall be replaced in the special absentee by mail and early voting ballot envelope or container. No rejected absentee by mail ballot shall be counted.

(6) After the validity of all absentee by mail ballots has been determined, the members of the board shall place the valid certificates and the flaps removed from the valid absentee by mail ballots in the envelope or container provided for that purpose and seal the envelope or container. Two of the members shall execute the certificate on the envelope.

(7) The members shall open the envelopes containing the valid absentee by mail ballots and remove the ballots.

(8) The board shall, in accordance with the requirements of R.S.18:1316, reject any ballot which contains a distinguishing mark or feature making the ballot susceptible of identification. However, a ballot shall not be rejected as containing a distinguishing mark if the ballot was transmitted electronically to a member of the United States Service, as defined in R.S.18:1302, or a person residing outside the United States.

54.

Despite these clear statutory mandates, the Petitioner has a reasonable belief that given the Clerk's comments and the information provided by a member of the Board of Election Supervisors, the law involving the review and adjudication of ballots was not followed on election night, which did affect the outcome of this election.

55.

Pursuant to La. R.S. §18:1313, the Petitioner requested not only a recount but to inspect the certificates or "flaps." Petitioner was informed November 27, 2023, that Petitioner would be

allowed to see the certificates or flaps after the scanned recount on November 27, 2023. This provided Petitioner with very little time to review the flaps and only a cursory review noted the numerous deficiencies that affected the outcome of the election.

56.

Following an abbreviated review of a portion of the certificates or “flaps,” the following irregularities have been identified.

57.

The certificates of multiple voters were not completed in accordance with the law, including lacking a signature or the voter’s name itself. Still other voters had their ballots witnessed by individuals that have witnessed more than one ballot of a non-family member in violation of Louisiana law. *See* Exhibit B for an exemplar list.

58.

Many absentee by mail ballots were signed by the same witness, who was not a family member of these putative voters, all of which is in violation of Louisiana law. *See* Exhibit B.

59.

The complained of conduct is consequential. All or any of these could have affected the outcome of this election, and likely did. They cast doubt on the unofficial results such that a hand recount in accordance with the law should be ordered and, if no certain result can be found, a new election be ordered by this Honorable Court.

REMEDIES SOUGHT

60.

But for these substantial irregularities, the error, fraud, and other unlawful actions detailed herein, the Petitioner would have been elected sheriff of Caddo Parish on November 18, 2023.

61.

The failure to properly adjudicate and count the absentee by mail ballots is a substantial irregularity, error, and an unlawful action which has directly affected the outcome of this Election.

62.

The failure to properly review the certificates or “flaps” for statutory compliance and the failure to review ballots for distinguishing marks is an unlawful action, substantially irregular, and an error that has directly affected the outcome of this Election.

63.

The various failures of voting machines, including the failure to count votes and the troubles reported in voting for Sheriff particularly, are substantial irregularities and error as to the reporting function of those machines, and have directly affected the outcome of this Election.

64.

The failure to allow a provisional ballot or other voting accommodations is a substantial irregularity, unlawful, and an error which directly affected the outcome of this Election.

65.

The process, procedure, individuals, and a direct benefit to voters for voting for a certain candidate is not only unlawful, but it is substantially irregular and, on information and belief, directly affected the outcome of this Election.

66.

Given all legal votes, the facts surrounding those votes, and a verifiable, accurate count, the Petitioner will ask the Court at trial to declare a winner, if the Election’s result is ascertainable, and if the evidence is irrefutable that there is a clear victor, or, more likely, that the process is so flawed that the Court should order a new election.

67.

The Louisiana Election Code at La. R.S. §18:1431 empowers this Court to make certain determinations when “one or more of the votes cast in a contested election are illegal or fraudulent:”

[T]he judge shall subtract such vote or votes from the total votes cast for the candidate who received them if the contest involves election to office, from the total vote for or against a proposition if the contest is of an election upon a proposition, or from the total vote for or against the recall of a public officer if the contest involves an election for the recall of a public officer. If the court determines that legal votes cast in the election were excluded in the total votes cast on a candidate, proposition, or recall, then these excluded legal votes shall be added to the total votes on the candidate, proposition, or recall to which they are attributable.

Thereafter, and after considering all the evidence, the court shall determine the result of the election.

68.

It is requested that this court order a complete and accurate recount, by hand, under the law. La. R.S. §18:1451 states that:

Prior to the trial of an election contest, a party to the suit by ex parte motion may seek a recount of the absentee by mail and early voting ballots if he alleges that there is an error in the counting of the absentee by mail and early voting ballots which would have changed the outcome of the election.

69.

Pursuant to La. R.S. §18:1406(B), it is suggested to this Honorable Court that the Petitioner may amend or supplement this pleading, for "good cause shown" and "in the interest of justice," as the candidate-requested recount of the absentee by mail ballots is currently set to begin on the same day as this filing, November 27, 2023.

70.

The results of the candidate-requested recount, and its effect on the Election, are not available at filing.

71.

On information and belief, the recount to be conducted on November 27, 2023, was not done in compliance with the law, as outlined *supra*.

72.

This Court should order a full and accurate recount, by hand, and order the Registrar of Voters, Board of Elections, and Clerk of Court to perform their duties pursuant to the law with respect to ballot counting, undervotes, overvotes, or distinguishing marks on a ballot.

73.

This Court should also order or request neutral or third-party, non-partisan individuals or good-government groups to oversee the recount, given the conduct complained of herein.

74.

Contemporaneous herewith the Petitioner is filing certain exhibits, including a sealed list of names of those whose votes or voting activity is in question.

75.

Petitioner also files herewith a Motion for the issuance of certain subpoenas *duces tecum* to the Clerk of Court, Registrar of Voters, and the Secretary of State for evidence and/or other information relating to the individuals who voted in this election and the number of questionable votes involved.

76.

Defendant **KYLE ARDOIN**, in his official capacity as Secretary of State of the State of Louisiana, is named herein as required by the election code.

77.



78.

Pursuant to La. R.S. §18:1409, this matter is to be tried “no later than 10:00 a.m. on the fourth day after suit was filed.”


WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that a trial on the merits be set within four (4) days of the filing of this suit as required by Louisiana law, that said trial commence no later than 10:00 a.m. on the trial date, that the Clerk of Court be directed to immediately post this suit as required by Louisiana law, and that, after due proceedings are held, this Honorable Court render a judgment declaring the victor of this election or that a new election be ordered. Petitioner further prays for all costs of proceedings together with general and equitable relief.


1. My name is Steve Wesley Mortimer, Sr. and I am a person of full age and majority and a resident of and domiciled in Caddo Parish, Louisiana for over 15 years, and do hereby make this affidavit based on my personal knowledge.
2. On November 18, 2023, I visited the polling place on Tacoma Street, in Shreveport, Louisiana, at which I have voted for over 13 or 14 years.
3. On Saturday, November 18, 2023, I entered the polling place on Tacoma to vote, and was told that I was not registered to vote. I am registered to vote in Caddo Parish, Louisiana and have voted at that polling place many years.
4. If I had been allowed to cast a ballot, I would have voted in the runoff election for Caddo Parish Sheriff.
5. When I returned home on Saturday, November 18, 2023, I immediately called the Caddo Parish Registrars of Voters office and reported the problem. I spoke with "Evelyn." I reported the problem to Evelyn and was told she would send me paperwork but I have not received same. I did not receive a return call from anyone at the Caddo Parish Registrars of Voters office after that.
6. If I had been given an opportunity to do so, I would have cast a provisional ballot and would have voted for Caddo Parish Sheriff.
7. Having learned that the election of Caddo Parish sheriff was decided by one vote, I called the Louisiana Secretary Of State's office and reported the problem and was told someone would contact me after the Thanksgiving Day Holiday.
8. At the time of my execution of this affidavit, I have received no further communication from the Louisiana Secretary of State's office.
9. I make this affidavit on my own personal knowledge, this 25 day of November, 2023, Shreveport, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

NOW COMES BEFORE ME, BRIAN A. HOMZA, Notary Public in and for Caddo Parish, Louisiana, CREIGHTON LIGHT, who based on his own personal knowledge, did depose and say the following:

1. My name is Creighton Light; I am a person over the age of 21, living and residing in Caddo Parish, Louisiana and do hereby make this affidavit based on my personal knowledge.

2. I am a person of full age and majority.

3. I am the Republican designee on the Caddo Parish Board of Election Supervisors and, in that capacity, have personal knowledge of the statements made herein and I do make these statements based on my personal knowledge.

4. The absentee by mail ballots, including the envelopes and certificates, are received by the Caddo Parish Registrar of Voters, where they are kept untouched until election day; the runoff election for Caddo Parish Sheriff was held on November 18, 2023.

5. The tabulation and counting of absentee by mail and early voting ballots for the November 18, 2023 election occurred on November 18, 2023.

6. On Saturday, November 18, 2023, employees of either the Clerk of Court or the Registrar of Voters examined the certificates of the absentee mail in ballots to determine whether the certificates complied with law. If a certificate was rejected by an employee, then the members of the Caddo Parish Board of Election Supervisors would review the certificate and make a final determination. For all certificates which were found to be in compliance with law, the certificates (also referred to sometimes as affidavits or tear offs) were separated from the sealed ballots by Registrar of Voters staff and separately stored.

7. On November 18, 2023, no further inspection was made of the certificates (also referred to as affidavits or tear offs).

8. On November 18, 2023, the absentee by mail ballots were removed from their sealed envelopes and placed in the counting (or scanning) equipment.

9. On November 18, 2023, the members of the Caddo Parish Board of Election Supervisors did not examine each individual ballot for distinguishing marks or other features which may make the ballot susceptible of identification. If a ballot was rejected or not read by



the counting machines, then the Caddo Parish Board of Election Supervisors would examine the individual rejected ballot.

10. On the evening of November 18, 2023, employees of the Clerk of Court's office fed the absentee by mail ballots into the scanning machines. The vote totals for all candidates were "merged" by Kevin Paul, an employee of the Louisiana Office of the Secretary of State.

11. It is my understanding that, when the scanning equipment was first used, the scanning equipment was very sensitive to improperly marked ballots. Sometime thereafter, the scanning equipment settings were changed so that the scanning equipment had a greater tolerance for ballots.

12. It is my understanding that the scanning machines used to count the absentee by mail ballots have a .002 margin of error.

13. After the November 18, 2023 election, candidate John Nickelson timely requested a hand recount of the absentee by mail ballots.

14. In a call with the members of the Caddo Parish Board of Election Supervisors, which Board is comprised of Dale Sibley, R. J. Johnson, Mike Spence, Brenda Traylor, and myself, there was a discussion about whether the recount should be done by hand or by the scanning machines. The consensus of the Board was to perform the recount using the scanning machines because a hand recount could not be timely performed due to the fact that November 23, 2023 and November 24, 2023 were holidays.

15. The only reason any member of the Caddo Board of Election Supervisors stated for refusing to conduct a hand recount of the ballots in the November 18, 2023 runoff election is that there was not time for a hand recount in light of the holidays.

16. Just last month, following the October 14, 2023 primary election for Louisiana House of Representatives District 4, Democratic candidate Lyndon B. Johnson requested a recount after thirty-two votes separated him from candidate Jasmine Greene out of 6,976 total votes cast in the unofficial returns reported by the Louisiana Secretary of State.


17. The Caddo Parish Board of Election Supervisors chose, in response to Mr. Johnson's request in that race, to conduct a hand recount of the absentee by mail ballots, which resulted in a net gain of three votes for Mr. Johnson.

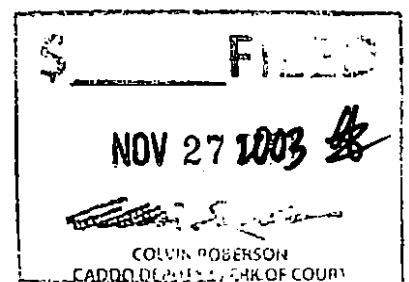


