Good afternoon, Judge Browning:

We are happy to report that the parties have agreed to substantive terms of settlement as follows:

1. The map agreed to on September 8, 2023 (attached), will be adopted by the San Juan County Commission on September 12, 2023, and the newly adopted map will remain in effect through the 2030 Census or until otherwise required by law.
2. Until the County adopts the attached map, the parties agree that the trial setting in this case shall be continued until September 18, 2023. If, as agreed, the County adopts the attached map, the parties agree that the trial setting on this case shall be vacated.
3. The parties have also agreed that the new map will take effect immediately upon adoption and will be in effect for the 2024 elections, with no special elections for District 1 and District 2. District 1 and District 2 elections will occur in 2026 as regularly scheduled.
4. The parties have agreed to issue a joint press statement after adoption of the map by the County Commission on September 12, 2023.

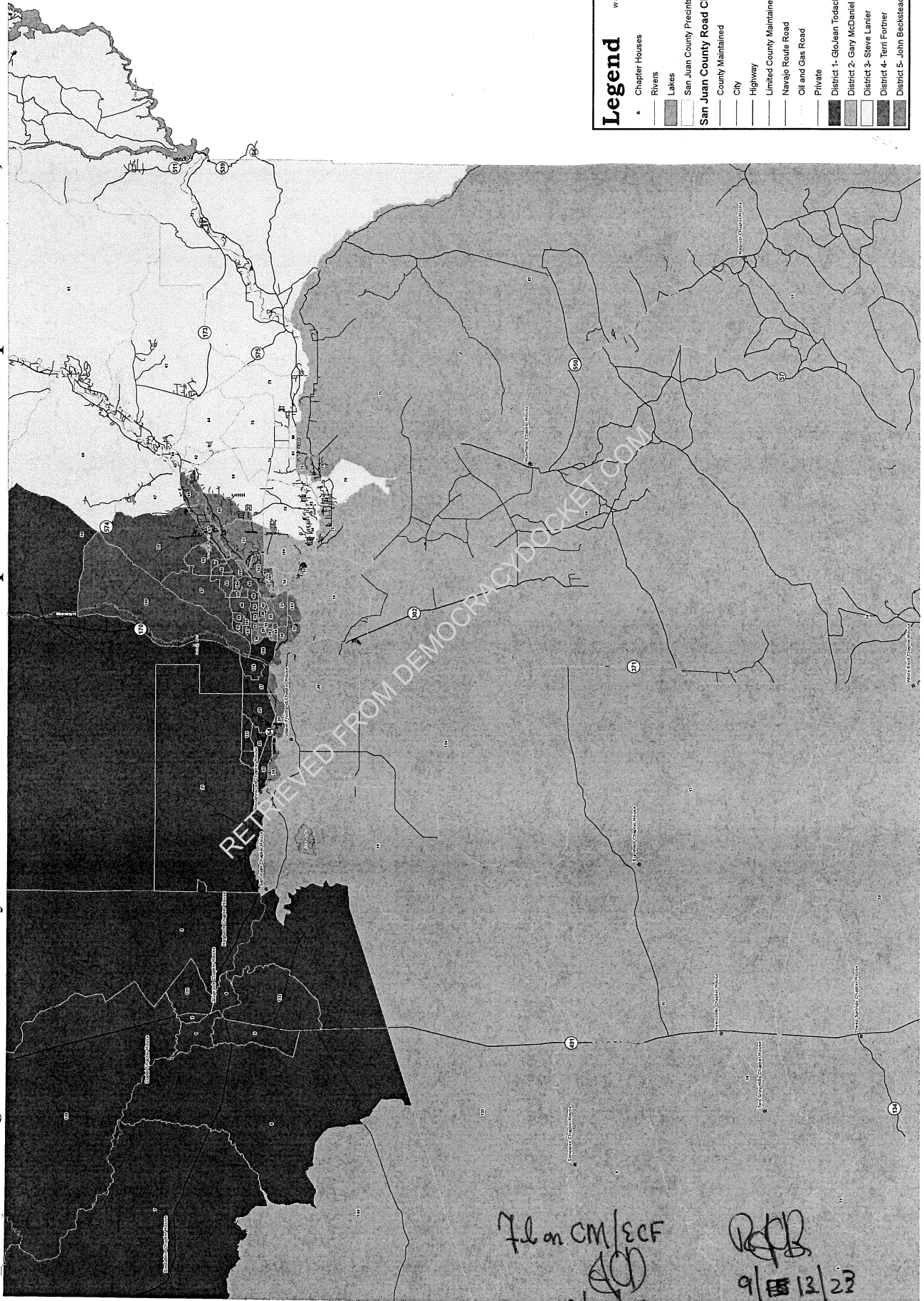
