STIPULATION OF DISCONTINUANCE

Pursuant to Pa. R.C.P. 229, and subject to approval of the Court, Plaintiff American Civil Liberties Union Foundation of Pennsylvania ("ACLU-PA"), Plaintiff Elizabeth Kurian, and Defendant York County Board of Elections ("Board of Elections") hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Board of Elections conducted the procedures outlined at 25 P.S. § 3154 in meetings that were open to the public during the 2024 general election cycle;

WHEREAS, the Board of Elections published precinct-by-precinct information showing the reconciliation of all ballots, which reflected the work of the canvass board; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Elections will continue to perform these activities in public in future elections absent a change in law,

NOW THEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Plaintiffs agree to discontinue the above-captioned lawsuit with prejudice, each party to bear its own costs.
